Growing up in an alcoholic family; my mother was terminally ill from the time I was 6-21 and then she died. Survived corporate takeover attempt in 1987. Attending the first Southern Global Citizens Circle and meeting Archbishop Tutu, Andrew Young, John Hume and Coretta Scott King.

4) Did you overcome obstacles - take risks - get lucky?

Overcame lots of obstacles; took a great deal of personal development seminars, did therapy and took many, many risks.

5) What have you done that no one would guess you'd done upon first meeting you? Walked on hot coals. Taught school in Jamaica at age 16. Never had children.

been asked to speak to several thousand impoverished women business owners in Kenya, Uganda and Tanzania. I really want to make that happen and get sponsorship money for that.
